Travel Requirements for traveling to the Dominican Republic with your pet



Animals must be accompanied by a health certificate issued and signed by a veterinarian. This certificate must be countersigned and stamped by an official veterinarian at the port of shipment.

The certificate must contain the name and address of the companion in the Dominican Republic and the complete identification of the animal (name, breed, sex, color, date of birth, microchip and/or tattoo).

Puppies must have received the Rabies vaccine at least 120 days after birth (4 months to 12 weeks) and wait 30 days after the application to travel.

Requisitos para viajar a República Dominicana con su mascota



Los animales deben estar acompañados de un certificado de salud expedido y firmado por un médico veterinario. Dicho certificado deberá estar contrafirmado y sellado por un veterinario oficial, en el puerto de embarque.

El certificado debe contener el nombre y dirección del acompañante en República Dominicana y la identificación completa del animal (nombre, raza, sexo, color, fecha de nacimiento, microchip y/o tatuaje).

Los cachorros deberán haber recibido la vacuna contra la Rabia al menos a los 120 días de nacimiento (4 meses a 12 semanas) y esperar 30 días después de la aplicación para viajar.

Los perros adultos con historial de vacuna y refuerzos de rabia no necesitan esperar los 30 días después de la aplicación antirrábica.
